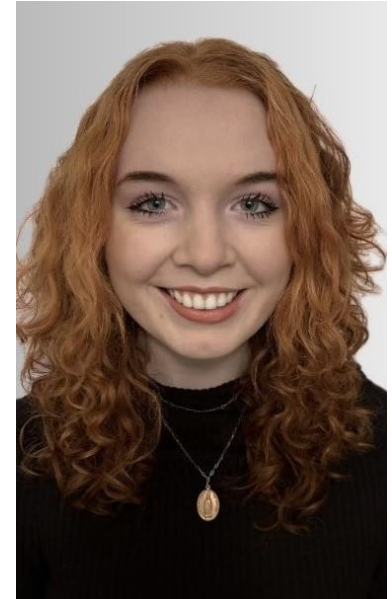

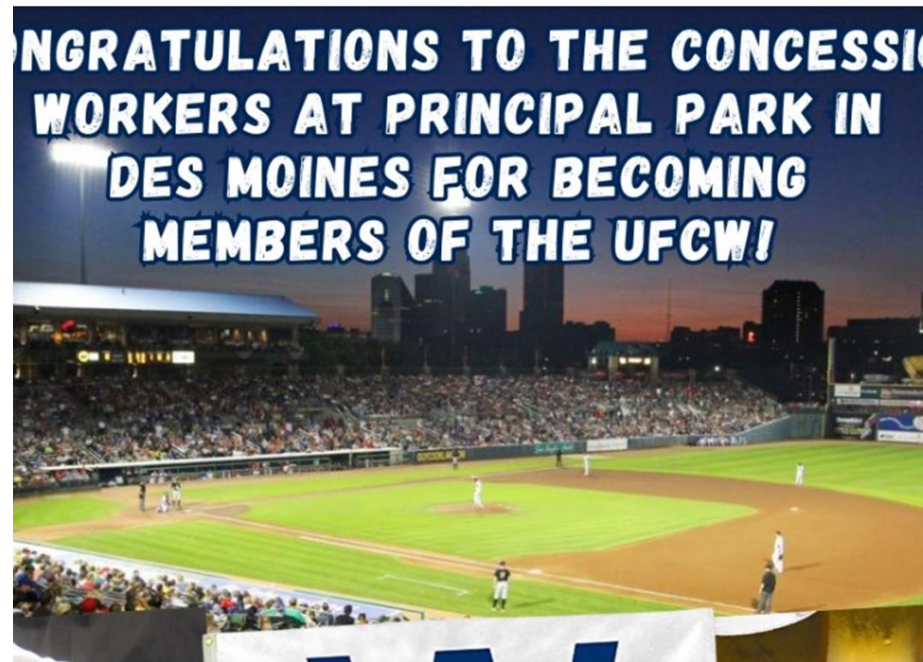

# Equity in Skilled Construction

- Iowa City ARPA: Of 29 total, 28 graduated from 5-week Fall 2023 course. 100% from communities underrepresented in trades.

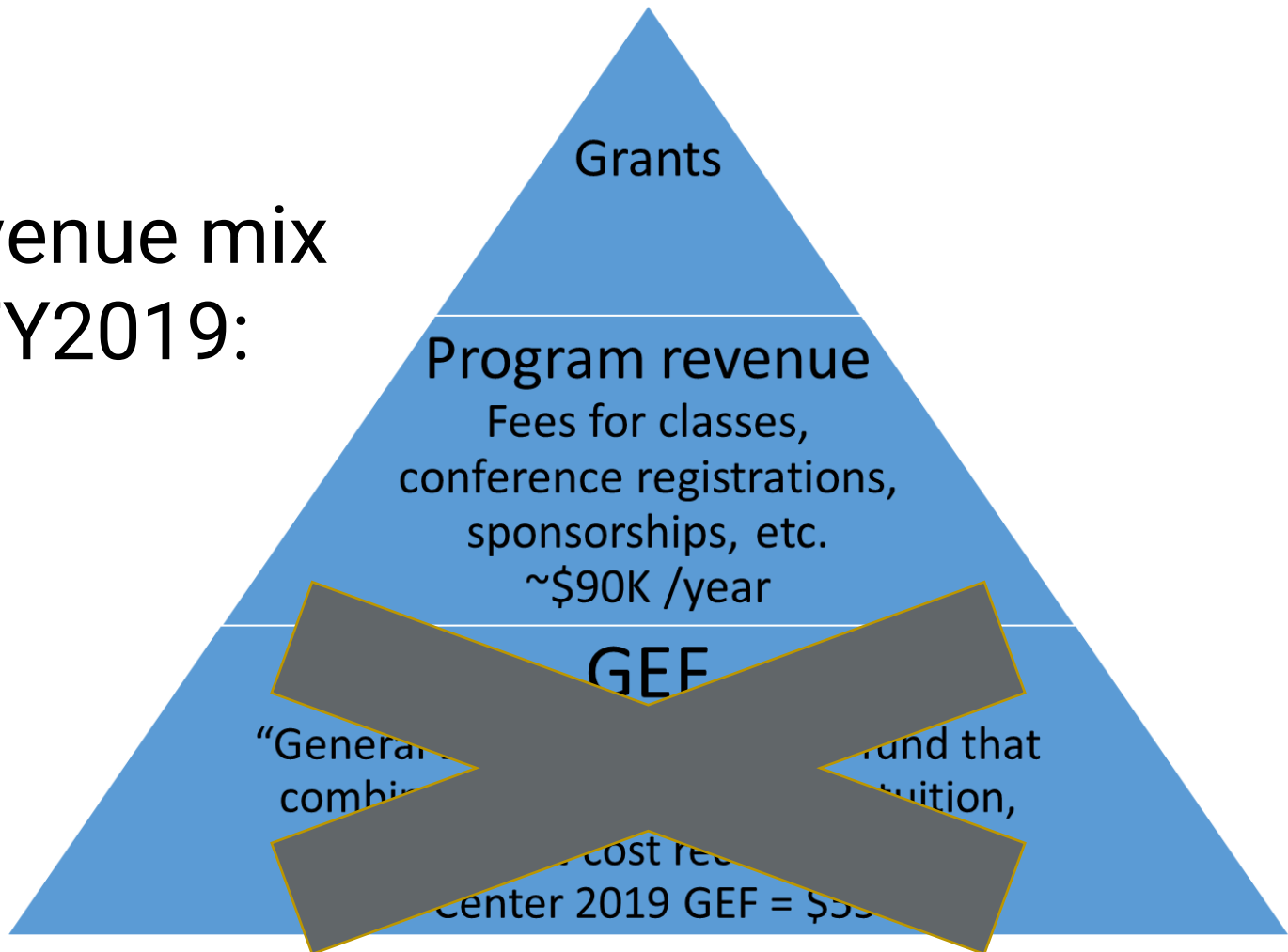
